**Theodore** Roosevelt Forester & Range Manager

The woman who was a noted humanitarian, author and columnist, delegate to the United Nations and active force in the Democratic party.

**Franklin** Roosevelt Actor & Announcer

Not quite 43, he became the youngest President in the Nation's history. Some of his most effective achievements were in conservation. He added enormously to the national forests in the West, reserved lands for public use, and fostered great irrigation projects.

ШіШ Rogers Lawyer & **Political** Scientist

Lawyer and 32nd president of the United States, in attacking the Great Depression he did much to develop a partial welfare state in the United States and to make the federal government an agent of social and economic reform. His administration indirectly encouraged the rise of organized labor and greatly invigorated the Democratic Party.
